Instruction


Step 1

Design your label in the COLOP e-mark® or COLOP e-mark create® App.



Step 2

Print on it. Use the COLOP e-mark® Ribbon Guide or the COLOP e-mark® Ruler for perfect positioning.

TIP! For optimal handling, leave the roll in the packaging and simply pull the label out along the upper marked  tab.



Attention! Full-surface, dark design elements can take longer to dry! Slow down your printing speed for an optimal imprint and avoid such elements if possible!

Step 3

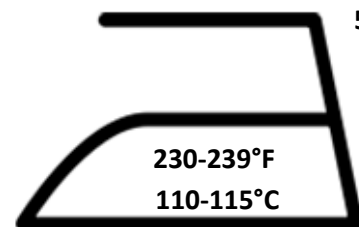
Cut off the label and place it on the desired location with the print facing up and then iron it on at 110-115 ° C for 5-10 seconds.

TIP! For better adhesion, the garment should have been washed once before use.

Attention! Wait 24 hours for the first wash! A reduction in the waiting time leads to faster fading of the labels.

Notes on care and service life

The color quality of the ironed-on label remains stable for about 5 washes at 40° C.

When using our Black Pigment Ink, good color quality can be extended at 60° C to over 10 washes.

It is possible to dry the ironed-on labels with a dryer.

When using a dryer, make sure that the garment is suitable for it.

The adhesive on the textile label will dissolve after about 4-5 cycles in the dryer.

TIP! This means that the label can be easily removed and the item of clothing can be re-labeled or passed on unlabeled.
